USA trip

Recently I was in the United States, meeting a number of friends in the Los Angeles area, always an encouraging time! Then I went to Houston to attend an International Leadership Institute (ILI) Conference where 46 participants from 23 countries took part.

For me this was a real spiritual encouragement as most of the participants came from the most difficult regions of the World and their testimonies and stories were mind-boggling! They all seemed to have arrived at the same conclusion, “the blood of martyrs produces the seeds for revival”.

There are more Muslims accepting Christ than ever before, but they pay a high price for their discipleship, leaving homelands, losing all possessions, often separated from their children, frequently losing their lives.

ILI programs of discipleship are used as a primary

tool for church planting and setting biblical standards for a transformed lifestyle. We in Poland have put some of that material into the courses presented on-line, as e-learning versions. There is now a massive interest in using it, but it is also a major task to translate, create localized content, get all the technology in place, etc..

More people needed

We see now in Wisla that we must enlarge our IT department, this is where all the software is written and where we provide a hosting/help desk service
